1. You are hereby notified, in accordance with Section 129 of the Companies Act 71 of 2008 (as amended) ("the Companies Act"), that the board of Directors of Nautic Africa Proprietary Limited ("the Company") adopted a resolution on 8 February 2018, in terms of which the Company voluntarily commence business rescue proceedings.

 - 4.3. a sworn statement of the facts relevant to the grounds on which the board resolution was founded; and
 - 4.4. the notice of appointment, form CoR123.2, filed with the Commission.
